
Message from the Board of Directors

ASCM Members,

I suspect everyone uses and depends on data in their roles in supply chain. Data, particularly live data, provides valuable insights into the status of the supply chain.

How are we using this data and applying data analytics to our decision-making process? Data analytics is the collection, transformation, and organization of data in order to draw conclusions, make predictions, and drive informed decision making. This is a pretty commonsense definition, but everyone could draw a different conclusion based on our own experiences.

I will give you an example of how data is used in the Supply Chain. In my role as forecast analyst, I receive important data from my top customers to help me create an accurate order forecast. Each week, I receive the following historical data: Point of Sale (POS), current inventory levels, and order history. I will add in the current forecast and use a chart to see if this passes the first visual test. I have a 13-week historical comparison between POS and orders and a 6-month future forecast. There will be deeper analysis done but this is one way that the customer data is applied in an easy-to-read chart.

Topic: General Overview and Challenges at Peak Foods



Jeff is extremely competitive in everything he does, he utilizes a data-driven approach, certified Six Sigma Black Belt and a certified Lean Implementer. He has worked at Peak since 2017, before that, he worked for Kraft/Heinz for eight years as a Plant Manager, Production Manager, and Continuous Improvement Manager. Prior to that, Jeff worked at Johnson Controls for fourteen years as a Continuous Improvement Manager, Lean Implementer, and a Network Engineer.

About the Presentation:

Jeff will speak about his experience at Peak Foods since joining the company in December 2017 as well as his experience in moving from a very large organization to a smaller organization and why he chose to make the career move. A lot has changed over the 5+ years since Jeff joined Peak Foods, as they continue to execute their plans to grow the business, remove costs, mitigate supply chain risks, and more. Jeff will also speak to the acquisition of the Blendtopia brand, along with the challenges and risk as Peak invests in and grows a startup brand. In addition to a general overview of the operations in Troy, highlighting their core business of frozen whipped topping, he will also speak to the challenges that the COVID pandemic brought on, both as related to supply chain issues and labor challenges throughout the industry.
