Reminder of Changes for APICS and Shoreline Chapter

In 2019, the Association for Supply Chain Management (ASCM) was launched. ASCM is the new, all-encompassing supply chain organization built on the foundation of APICS. Since it has launched, there have been adjustments that have been made to help further build on what APICS has already started.

As of January 1,2021, the Shoreline APICS Chapter will be transitioning into the Shoreline ASCM Forum. Shoreline will no longer be a chapter.

Why is this change occurring?

- Supply chain professionals have changed and they learn and engage differently than they have in the past. To address this, there have been structure changes to all chapters.
- ASCM has made the decision to adapt its North American chapter structure to enable ASCM and its partners to better meet the professional engagement needs of its members and for the local community.

What does this mean for you?

• The Shoreline organization will continue to provide opportunities to connect with fellow Supply Chain professionals and build your professional network, enhance your supply chain skills and knowledge, maintain your APICS certifications, and foster your professional growth.

- We will no longer be providing APICS certification training as we have in the
 past. We will work with ASCM chapters to make sure your APICS training
 needs are met.
- If you are currently a members of the Shoreline Chapter, the transition to the Shoreline Forum will be seamless. At the time of your renewal in 2021, you will be given the option to stay with Shoreline Forum or select a different option if you so choose.
- If you are signing up to be a new member in 2021, you will be given the option to chose to be part of the Shoreline Forum.

As we move forward you will see updates to our email address, website, and social media platforms as we make the change to becoming the Shoreline Forum. We appreciate your understanding during the transition.
