Greetings to All Members and Friends of ASCM Forum,

2023: The Year the Global Supply Chain Bounces Back!

It's been said many times but bears repeating, the past few years exposed all of the vulnerabilities in the supply chain. The pandemic dislodged the global supply chain, hurling once smoothly running businesses, industries and economies into a state of disarray. A recent Gartner survey found that 76% of supply chain executives say their company is facing more frequent disruptions than three years ago. Meanwhile, shipment delays between China and major United States and European ports have quadrupled since March 2022.
